# **Board of Education Meeting Recap**

The Township High School District 211 Board of Education met on Thursday, January 16, 2014, in the Anne Koller Board Meeting Room at the G.A. McElroy Administration Center. The following is a recap of important items that were acted upon at the meeting.

## Recognitions
