Settling Disputes

If your school district does not agree with your McKinney-Vento eligibility, you must be provided with a written explanation of the district's intent to dispute. Your school district must also provide you with a list of low-cost or free legal services to assist you during the dispute/appeal process. Once you have received notice that your district has filed for dispute, please contact your regional liaison, named on the back tab of this pamphlet.

In the event of a dispute, your Regional Office of Education or Intermediated Service Center will appoint a mediator. The mediator will set a meeting time that is convenient for you and the
